RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Read Horse General Rules and Regulations in the fair booklet.
2. Proof of valid liability insurance must be presented.
3. All riders under 18 years of age must wear ASTM & BSI APPROVED hard hats with attached harness while mounted.
4. Rider, Parent and/or Guardian must sign a waiver in order to be allowed to participate in the show.
5. Ponies or horses are allowed. No stallions.
6. English or western tack is acceptable. Proper footwear to be worn at all times.
7. Entry Fee: Classes \$3 per class
8. There will be a \$2 deposit on numbers that will be refunded when you submit your number back to show office at the ring.
9. Riders must leave the ring when excused or run the risk of being dismissed from the remaining classes.
10. Peewee Rider – 11 years and under.
11. Youth Rider – 12-17 years

12. Open Rider – 12 and over
13. Open classes are open to ages 12 and over. Riders are allowed to show youth and open classes.
14. All riders must be wearing a number in order to compete.
15. During warm-up hours (8:00-8:45 am) if asked to leave the ring, you must do so immediately. If asked a third time, rider will be disqualified from all entered classes with NO REFUND.
16. JUDGE'S DECISION WILL BE FINAL IN ALL RESPECTS OF THE SHOW.
17. Class list is filled out as entries are received, once filled out there will be No Changes to the order of go.
18. Riders who have brought more than one horse or horses that have more than one rider and require space between their runs MUST indicate this information at the time of registration. This applies for tack change as well; if you require time for a tack change please indicate that at the time of registration. Riders will be called to the chute 3 times, if rider is not at the shoot for their run by the third call they will be eliminated from that class.
19. Show changes and/or corrections will be posted on website and at registration booth day of show.
