Pint jars or metric equivalent are required for Canning. 1/2 pint jars or metric equivalent are required for Jams & Jellies. **Wrong sized jars will be disqualified.** Should there be more than 6 entries in any section, a 4th prize of \$2 may be given. Entries must be in place by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may not be removed until 4:45 Monday of the Fair.

NOTE: NEW LIDS ONLY TO BE USED. JARS NOT SEALED WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. NO WAX TO BE USED EXCEPT FOR FREEZER JAM.
