### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Antiques must be at least 50 years old.
2. Please use small sized entry tags.
3. Exhibitors must have a number and may not enter more than 1 entry in each section.
4. Exhibitors should own articles exhibited. No exhibit to be higher than 12 inches.
5. Historical interest and approximate age of entry would be appreciated but is not necessary for a prize.
6. Each exhibitor is requested to keep a list of articles exhibited as a check at the close of the fair.
7. All showcases will be locked for exhibitors' protection.
8. In fairness to other exhibitors, dealers in Antiques will not be eligible to compete.
9. Articles to be removed from cases by Directors only, for safety.
10. Only class directors to be allowed beyond the tables during judging.
11. If more than six (6) qualified entries in one section, a 4th prize of \$1.50 will be given on the advice of the judge.
12. All entry tickets must be securely fastened to the article exhibited.
13. Entries to be placed in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am on Friday, and may not be removed until 4:45 pm on Monday.
