4. All entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor.
5. ALL CATTLE TO BE LEFT ON THE GROUNDS UNTIL 4:30 PM.

7. **All livestock/equine exhibitors must provide proof of insurance with policy number, name of insurance company and expiry date on Entry Forms.**

13. Senior 2-year-old Female, born September 1, 2016 to February 28, 2017 in milk
14. 3-year-old Female, born September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2016 in milk
15. 4-year-old Female, born September 1, 2014 to August 31, 2015 in milk
16. 5-year-old Female, born September 1, 2013 to August 31, 2014 in milk
17. Mature Cow born prior to September 1, 2013 in milk
18. BEST BRED & OWNED: top bred and owned cow chosen from each section 11 to 17. \$50 Jersey Canada gift certificate.

19. GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE: chosen from first 2 placings in Sections 11 to 17. Rosette. **Award donated by LINWOOD VETERINARY SERVICE.**
20. RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE: Rosette.
21. BEST UDDER: Judge shall designate best two udders in Sections 11 to 17. These shall compete for first and second Best Udder in the show. Prize money paid to first and second place only.
