Show to Commence at 9:30 am, Monday, October 14, 2019

RULES:

1. All of the General Rules and Regulations listed earlier in this book are applicable, unless overridden below.
2. All entries must be made in advance. Entries must be in the hands of the show secretary Maureen Dyke by October 1, 2019. Mail entries to Maureen Dyke, 243099 5 Sideroad, Amaranth, ON L9W 0V4
3. The Rabbit and Cavy show will take place on the Monday (Thanksgiving Day) of the Fair.
4. Entry fee will be \$3 per animal.
5. Gate fee will be paid in lieu of exhibitor fee.
6. This will be a cooped show.
7. Entries must be cooped by 8:30 am
8. Judging will commence at 9:30 am
9. No animals are to be removed until 4:30 pm.
10. The Erin Agricultural Society will take all precautions to insure the safety and

welfare of the rabbits and cavies, but will not be responsible for loss or damage whatsoever, all rabbits and cavies being at the sole risk of the exhibitor.

11. The Judges' decision shall be final. The new revised D.R. and D.B.A. Standard of Perfection shall be the guide therein and all rabbits and cavies shall be judged by comparison.
12. All rabbits and cavies must be healthy. Any animals showing signs of illness will be removed from the show area.

YOUTH CLASS

34. Any pet rabbit exhibited by a youth under 18 years of age. The \$2.50 entry fee per rabbit will apply. Limit two entries per exhibitor. The pet rabbit may be a standard breed or a mixed breed. Youth must handle rabbit.

PET CLASS

2. Any pet cavy exhibited by a youth under 18 years of age. The \$3 entry fee per cavy will apply. Limit two entries per exhibitor. The pet cavy may be a standard breed of a mixed breed. Youth must handle cavy.

Exhibitors can show a Rabbit or Cavy. Judging will be done on presentation and knowledge of the animal. Some age appropriate questions will be asked by judge.
