INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ RULES CAREFULLY.

Only One Entry Per Person Per Section. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.** EACH ENTRY MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR, MUST BE CLEAN AND WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED 2 YEARS. NOTE: PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO NEW WORK. Any change on entry card must be made through the Committee Head only. NOTE: Combined sewing machine and serging techniques will be accepted on garments unless otherwise specified. Should there be more than 6 entries in any section and on the advice of the judge, a 4th prize will be given.

All entry tags must be fastened securely to the garment ONLY with safety pins. Before removing entries from the hall, exhibitors must present their membership ticket and exhibitor number.

SECTION:

1. A child's outfit (at least 2 coordinating pieces)
2. Coordinating pieces for an adult (at least 2 pieces ie. jacket and skirt, etc.)
3. A man or woman's shirt, tailored style
4. An article of outer wear, ie. coat, hat, etc.
5. Jacket, woven fabric – any style
6. Pants – Any size with waistband and zipper
7. Pants – Any size with elastic waistband
8. Hoodie or Sweatshirt, any size
9. Fleece jacket with zipper, any size
10. Pajamas or nightshirt, child or adult
11. Clothing accessory made of fleece, ie. hat, mittens, etc.
12. Costume for child or adult
13. Sewn accessory – ie. hat, mittens, bag, wallet, etc.
14. A sewn doll's outfit made for a 14" to 18" doll. Displayed on the doll.
15. Apron – Any style

16. Handmade garment or accessory using Eco-friendly materials such as recycled garments, fabrics or materials or bamboo, soy or corn based fabrics. Must use some sewing techniques which may include hand sewing. Please attach an explanation of the Eco-friendly aspects of the garment or accessory.

KNITTED AND CROCHETED ARTICLES CLASS 36

Entries may be picked up after closing ceremonies, beginning at 4:00 pm Monday of the fair.

SECTION KNITTED:

1. Afghan, hand knitted, one piece, finished not exceeding 150 cm x 180 cm
2. Afghan, hand knitted, squares, finished not exceeding 150 cm x 180 cm
3. Hand knitted baby's afghan or carriage cover any style (min. size 36" x 36")
4. Hand knitted pair of socks, adult size
