INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ HOMECRAFT AND QUILTING RULES CAREFULLY. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.**

No person shall be permitted to enter more than one article per section in each class. Each entry must be the work of the exhibitor, must be clean, and may be shown only two years. Preference will be given to new work. Soiled and damaged articles will not be accepted.

Should there be more than six (6) entries in any section, on the advice of the judge, a 4th prize will be given. At the discretion of the judge, with the approval of the Committee Head, a given class may be subdivided to make judging and competition as appropriate as possible. Entry tags must be fastened securely with safety pins. Exhibitors are required to present their current exhibitor ticket and number, with a list of entries, to a director before removing entries.

ALL ENTRIES IN CLASS 38 MUST MEET THE SIZE REQUIREMENTS AS STIPULATED FOR EACH SECTION. FAILURE TO MEET THE SIZE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. ALL LABELS MUST BE COVERED.

OAAS ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUILTS COMPETITION

A COMPLETE SET OF ELIGIBILITY, RULES AND REGULATIONS IS AVAILABLE

The two championship quilts (hand quilted and machine quilted) are eligible to compete at the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) District meeting in November 2019. The winners at District proceed to competition at the OAAS Convention in Toronto in February 2020. If an exhibitor does not wish his or her quilt to compete, please state on the back of the entry tag. If the championship winner does not want the champion quilt to proceed, the reserve champion quilt will proceed to the OAAS Quilt Competition. Upon making an entry into the OAAS Quilt Competition, the exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition. Prizes will be awarded at the District and Provincial Levels.

HAND QUILTED CHAMPIONSHIP: RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entries must be solely made and hand quilted by the exhibitor.
- Entry quilts must be a minimum of 324" (823 cm) measured on the perimeter
- The Grand Prize winner of the Hand Quilted Championship Quilt will receive an award of \$500 at the Convention in February 2020.

MACHINE QUILTED CHAMPIONSHIP: RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entries must be solely made and machine quilted (not using a long arm machine) by the exhibitor.
- Entries must be a minimum perimeter of 324" (823 cm). Article may be square or rectangular, etc.
- Article must have visible machine quilting.
- The Grand Prize winner of the Champion Machine Quilt will receive an award of \$500 at the Convention in February 2020.

3. Quilt – pieced or appliquéd, machine quilted, made solely by exhibitor.

GENERAL QUILTING SECTIONS

THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS REQUIRE THAT THE QUILTS BE MADE SOLELY BY THE EXHIBITOR. PLEASE NOTE THAT SECTIONS 29 AND 30 ONLY ARE AVAILABLE FOR QUILTS QUILTED BY ANOTHER PERSON OR QUILTED ON A LONG ARM QUILTING MACHINE.

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THE ENTRY MEETS THE SIZE REQUIREMENTS

OTHER SECTIONS:

4. Quilt – My first quilt by a beginner quilter, perimeter of 200" (500 cm) or larger (any kind, machine, hand quilted or tied)
5. Quilt – tied, perimeter of 200" (500 cm) or larger
6. Quilt Top – appliquéd, perimeter of 200" (500 cm) or larger
7. Quilt Top – pieced, perimeter of 200" (500 cm) or larger
8. Quilt – whole cloth (quilted on a solid plain coloured fabric), perimeter of 300" (750 cm) or larger
9. Quilt, Appliquéd – any kind done solely by exhibitor that is not eligible for Sections 1 to 8. Please write on the back of the entry tag the uniqueness of this quilt which makes it ineligible for the previous Sections; i.e. size
10. Quilt, Pieced – any kind done solely by exhibitor that is not eligible for Sections 1 to 8. Please write on the back of the entry tag the uniqueness of this quilt which makes it ineligible for the previous Sections; i.e. size

11. Quilt – crib, hand quilted, perimeter of 200" (500 cm) or less. (See section 33 for additional prize)
12. Quilt – crib, machine quilted, perimeter of 200" (500 cm) or less.
13. Lap Quilt – hand quilted, perimeter of more than 200" (500 cm), less than 300" (750 cm). (See section 33 for additional prize)
14. Lap Quilt – machine quilted, perimeter of more than 200" (500 cm), less than 300" (750 cm).
15. Bed Quilt – hand quilted, minimum perimeter of 300" (750cm) (See section 33 for additional prize)
16. Bed Quilt – machine quilted, minimum perimeter of 300" (750cm)
17. Quilted Runner or Table Topper
18. Quilted Bag, Purse or Wearable Item
19. Any other quilted or tied item, i.e. place mats, candle mats etc.
20. Quilted item showing theme of Fair

21. Pieced or appliquéd quilt block, mounted with back of block accessible

22. Miniature Quilt, perimeter of 72" (180 cm) or less

23. Wall Quilt – Traditional or heirloom design, not to exceed a perimeter of 200" (500 cm). Must be made and quilted by exhibitor. **MUST HAVE SLEEVE OR ROD POCKETS.**

24. Wall Quilt – Contemporary or own design, not to exceed a perimeter of 200" (500 cm). Will be judged on innovative design, unusual use of materials and stitches, piecing, embellishments, as well as quilting and finishing. **MUST HAVE SLEEVE OR ROD POCKETS.**

25. Men Only – Any quilt or quilted item

This quilt should exhibit a special theme (ie. specific event or celebration) or special design (ie. exhibitor's ability to design original or adapt traditional pattern) or other special qualities (ie. personalized photo transfer memory quilt). Include a note (legible from a distance) of 100 words or less describing the special nature of the quilt.
