INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ RULES CAREFULLY. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.** EACH ENTRY MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR, MUST BE CLEAN AND WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ONE YEAR. Any change on the entry card must be done by the Secretary only. Should there be more than six entries in any section, and on the advice of the judge, a fourth prize may be given. Entry tags must be securely fastened. Exhibitors are required to present their membership ticket and exhibitor's number, with a list of entries to the Director in charge before removing entries on Monday.

NOTE: Exhibitor may enter one item only per section.

SECTION: HOBBIES & CRAFTS

1. Hostess gift "Welcome to Your New Home"
2. Any occasion front door entrance decoration, other than Christmas
3. A sewn or knitted or crocheted teddy bear or stuffed animal
4. An article made from a man's work sock
5. A handmade pin cushion
6. Jewellery – Handmade bracelet
7. Jewellery – 2 piece set (necklace/earrings or other). Mounted for display
8. Jewellery – 3 piece set (necklace/bracelet/earrings). Mounted for display
9. Jewellery – an item for a special occasion
10. Jewellery – any other kind not listed above
11. An article showing tie-dying technique
12. Adult Colouring Book Page, mounted on Bristol board with one inch border
13. Garden ornament – stake, stepping stone or other
14. A quilted wall hanging ready to hang

SECTION: NEEDLEWORK: All articles must be clean and new.

Please observe measurements!

15. Article of **counted cross-stitch (floss) - Needlework** to measure under 10" by 10" (25 cm by 25 cm), - **not framed so that the back may be seen.**
Edges to be over cast.
16. **Counted Cross-stitched** picture – **framed**, over 10" by 10" (25.4 cm), but no larger than 15" by 15" (38 cm by 38 cm). (Frame included in the measurement.)
17. An article displaying **embroidery** with floss not framed
18. An article displaying **embroidery – framed**. Label the technique on the tag
19. An article displaying **machine embroidery**
20. A **crocheted** article larger than 12 inches (30 cm). (See Class 36)
21. An article of **crocheting**, mounted for display, under 12 inches (30 cm)
22. A handmade bookmark, any medium
23. Three articles for a bazaar, displayed in a basket
24. Sample of a craft or hobby, not listed above or below.
25. An article made from recycled material. On card state "From _____"
26. NEW ADULT EXHIBITOR: any craft, hobby, needlework not listed above.
Mark card as NEW.

SECTION: CHRISTMAS CORNER

27. A wall hanging or Advent calendar
28. Front door entrance decoration – snowman, New Year, Winter, etc.
29. Runner or table topper
30. A decorated Christmas bag, any medium
31. A handcrafted snowman or Santa
32. A handmade tree ornament, ready to hang
33. An item displaying any technique not listed in a previous category (feather, wool, etc.)
34. A Christmas centerpiece, any medium, (except real flowers), height 8", (20 cm), for buffet table
