INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Antiques must be at least 50 years old.
2. Exhibitors must have a number and may not enter more than 1 entry in each section.
3. Exhibitors should own articles exhibited. No exhibit to be higher than 12 inches.
4. Historical interest and approximate age of entry would be appreciated but is not necessary for a prize.
5. Each exhibitor is requested to keep a list of articles exhibited as a check at the close of the fair.
6. All showcases will be locked for exhibitors' protection.
7. In fairness to other exhibitors, dealers in Antiques will not be eligible to compete.
8. Articles to be removed from cases by Directors only, for safety.
9. Only class directors to be allowed beyond the tables during judging.
10. If more than six (6) qualified entries in one section, a 4th prize of \$1.50 will be given on the advice of the judge.
11. All entry tickets must be securely fastened to the article exhibited.

12. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.**

INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ FAIR RULES CAREFULLY. Each entry must be the work of the exhibitor and only one entry per section. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.** Entries from Sections 1 - 26 must be in CLEAR PLASTIC ZIPPER BAGS PROVIDED BY THE EXHIBITOR WITH TAGS ATTACHED. Exhibitors shall present their exhibitor card with a list of entries shown, before removing exhibits Monday at 4:30 pm.

SECTION: BREAD & ROLLS (YEAST)

For Sections 1 and 2 loaf pan should be 8" x 4" x 2 1/2" min., and 9" x 5" x 3" max. Bread machine only permitted in Section 3. A whole loaf should be presented for judging. Half will be displayed and the remaining half may be picked up at 5:00 pm Friday.

1. One loaf white bread
2. One loaf 60% whole wheat bread
3. One loaf of multi-grain bread, using a bread machine
4. Braided fruit loaf
5. Three Sour dough buns, presented on a 6" plate
6. Three Chelsea buns, presented on a 6" - 8" (approx.) foil plate

Exhibitor with top points accumulated in Sections 1 – 6 will receive an additional \$20 gift certificate and the runner-up will receive an additional \$10 gift certificate.
