INSTRUCTIONS: The Junior sections are open to boys and girls who have reached their 16th birthday by the end of the Fall Fair year. Please fill out the information on the entry cards and include the child's age to be visible when the card is **folded**. Fasten entry tags securely to all entries. No entries will be accepted for more than two years. All entries must be the work of the child. Parents are encouraged to allow the children to prepare the exhibits without assistance. Please encourage them in every way, but remember that every bit of work you do for them defeats the objectives of the Fair. Only one entry per section per child permitted and children must exhibit in their own age group only. ALL PICTURES AND PAINTINGS MADE ON PAPER MUST NOT EXCEED 8 1/2 x 11 INCHES UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS FOR EACH SECTION AS THEY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF NOT MADE TO THE APPROPRIATE SIZE. No exhibitor fee is required, however all exhibitors must obtain an exhibit number before entering their items. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. Please ensure that you arrange to have your entries picked up as we cannot be responsible for them after Monday.

Examples of any medium, would be; paint, markers, crayons, pencil crayons, oil pastels, bingo dabbers, chalk, ribbon, yarn, string, lace, feathers, buttons, pompoms, stickers, paper, fabric, noodles, shells, puzzle pieces, flowers, beads, sparkles, sequins, tooth picks, pipe cleaners, googly eyes, popsicle sticks, foam pieces, clothes pins, wooden spoons, dice, play dough, felt, sponges, elastics, milk tags, gimp, items from nature, cotton balls, egg cartons, candies, etc.

Ages 2 and under: PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND MAKE SURE ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 1. Pencil Holder decorate a soup can with any medium.
- 2. Collection of Nature items collect 5 different nature items and display on a paper plate.
- 3. Dressed up Teddy dress up a teddy bear that looks like they are ready to attend the Fair.
- 4. Corn Cob Prints dip a cob of corn into some paint and then roll it all over your paper and see what "corny design" you can come up with.

- 5. Farm Animal Colouring sheet find a picture of a farm animal of your choosing and colour it using any medium.
- 6. Pom Pom Flower using a flower template, glue your favourite coloured pom poms on to decorate it.

Ages 3 & 4: PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND THAT ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 7. Plasticine Farm Animal create a farm animal out of plasticine and display on a small paper plate.
- 8. Fruit and Vegetable Prints using different pieces of fruit and vegetables, dip them into paint and press onto a sheet of paper no bigger than a 12" x 18".
- 9. Finger Family Trace your hand and decorate it into a finger family.
- 10. Christmas Ornament using any medium, create a Christmas tree ornament that is ready to be hung on a tree.
- 11. Mud Pie using an aluminum pie plate, fill it with mud then decorate it with items collected from nature.
- 12. My Favourite Colour Collection using a pint sized mason jar, fill it with items that are your favourite colour.

Ages 5 - 7: PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND THAT ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 13. Repeating Pattern using objects found in nature, create a repeating pattern.
- 14. Your Name using seeds and or pasta, create your name displayed on a piece of cardboard.
- 15. "Bounty from the County" collage using pictures that would describe the fair theme, create a collage on not to exceed $8\ 1/2$ " x 11".
- 16. Wooden Spoon Farm Animal Using a wooden spoon create any animal that you would see on a farm.
- 17. Thanksgiving Table Centrepiece using any medium create a centrepiece for your dinner table not to exceed 12" x 12"
- 18. Bowl of Spaghetti using only paper products, create spaghetti and toppings and glue them onto a paper bowl to display.

Ages 8 -11: PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND THAT ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 19. Fair themed CD cover using a CD case and plasticine create a scene with the Fair theme "Bounty from the County".
- 20. Farm Animal Wanted Poster create a wanted poster for a farm animal that has gotten itself into some mischief. Not to exceed 11" x 17" (legal sized paper).

- 21. Bingo using any medium create a full card for Bingo with the fair theme present, not to exceed 11" x 17" (legal sized paper)
- 22. Homemade Thank you Card for a Farmer using a piece of card stock or bristol board, create a one of a kind thank you card for a farmer.
- 23. Seed and Grain Picture using a heavier piece of paper, create an interesting picture or design using only seeds and grains
- 24. Farm Machinery select 5 pictures of different farm machinery, display and label creatively.

Ages 12-16: PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND THAT ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 25. Seed or Bean Picture using a real bean or seed, glue it onto a piece of paper then draw what the rest of it would look like if it was full grown.
- 26. Zentangle create a one of a kind zentangle not to exceed 5" x 5" then mount on a piece of construction paper.
- 27. String Art choose something related to the fair theme and create a string art not to exceed 12" x 12".
- 28. Scrapbook Page create a scrapbook page with an interest of yours being the theme.
- 29. Free Standing Farmer using nuts, bolts and screws, create a free standing farmer not to exceed 8".
- 30. Diorama using a shoe box, create a diorama with the fair theme "Bounty from the County".

Junior Gardening & Horticulture: PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND THAT ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 31. Create an animal out of a vegetable of fruit.
- 32. "Soups on" using a soup can with the label still attached, create an arrangement using live flowers and greenery.
- 33. Thanksgiving Harvest Basket using a basket not exceeding 12", create a display using fruits, vegetables and flowers.

Junior Photography: Photos must have been taken by the exhibitor. Include one print only in each section mounted on construction paper with a one inch border. Not to exceed 5" x 7". PLEASE INDICATE AGE ON OUTSIDE OF ALL ENTRY TAGS AND THAT ALL RULES HAVE BEEN READ AND FOLLOWED.

- 34. A field of crops.
- 35. A barn or building found in Wellington County (include address).

- 36. My Garden flower or vegetable.
- 37. Insect(s).
- 38. Storyboard using 4 6 pictures mounted in order together to tell a story.
- 39. A Wellington County School.
