RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. The contestant must be able to pedal the tractor without assistance.
2. Pedal tractors will be furnished for all participants.
3. All contestants must wear shoes.
4. All contestants will be given two (2) chances to get the sled moving from the starting line.
5. The pulling tractor must stay between the lines of the pulling lane at all times.
6. If the tractor leaves the pulling lane, the distance will be measured from the starting line to the point where the tractor crossed the boundary.
7. In case of a tie, there will be a pull-off to determine the winner.
8. The Judge's decision will be final for all pulls.
9. All contestants must be present at the time of the pedal pull and have a guardian sign the permission slip. The required signature of parent or guardian releases the Erin Agricultural Society from any financial responsibility due to an accident.
