3. Exhibitors are asked to put their cattle chutes outside the barns to allow sufficient tie up space for all exhibitors. Space is limited – please be considerate.
4. **LIVESTOCK ENTRIES MAY NOT BE REMOVED BEFORE 4:30 pm**
5. All purebred animals must be registered and pedigrees must be produced at Fair when requested by the Directors in charge.
6. The Erin Agricultural Society will not guarantee hydro and/or shelters for all Exhibitors.
7. General rules of the Erin Agricultural Society apply. **Insurance company and Policy # must be on entry form**
8. **ALL EXHIBITORS PAY AT GATE IN LIEU OF ENTRY FEE.**
9. A \$5 administration fee will be deducted from prize money.
