The Erin Agricultural Society has authorized two entries per section to a maximum of two sections and the exhibitor has his or her choice of sections in which to make the second entry. Single Market Lamb Class, one entry per exhibitor. All entries must be owned and registered in the name of the exhibitor.

PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$40, 2nd \$35, 3rd \$32, 4th \$27, 5th \$25. \$20 to all remaining entries. Fair Board reserves the right to pay only half the prize money if less than three exhibitors in a Section.

No prize money will be paid unless animals are exhibited in the show ring and properly judged including Sections 5 & 6.

SECTIONS:

1. Ewe - Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place)
2. Ewe Lamb - First pair of temporary incisors must be in place.
3. Best Pair of Ewes, any age.
4. Ram - Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place).
5. Ram Lamb - First pair of temporary incisors must be in place.
6. Get of Sire - Group of three animals, first pair of temporary incisors must be in place, from one sire. Both sexes may be represented.

Benham Memorial Challenge Trophy. Winner to receive Keeper Trophy.

7. **ROSS MACK MEMORIAL TROPHY** - For Overall Champion Suffolk from Class 6, Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4. In honour of the late Ross Mack, an Honorary Life Member of the Erin Agricultural Society, a local farmer and Suffolk breeder for many years. Winners name will be engraved thereon and will remain the property of the fair. Keeper trophy to be given each year to the exhibitor.
