NEW: AMATEUR WINEMAKERS COMPETITION

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- A. The Judge’s decision is final; any disputed judgments result in immediate disqualification of the entry of the disputed wine.
- B. Judging based on colour, clarity, bouquet, flavour, balance and quality.
- C. All entries become property of the Erin Agricultural Society and will be disposed of in accordance with the Alcohol and Gaming Commission Regulations.
- D. All wines are to be made by Amateur Winemakers and submitted in standard clear green, amber or blue 750 ml wine bottles, with cork or screw top.
NOTE: each bottle must be labeled with the following information: Your name, category, ingredients and vintage. Also include an Erin Fall Fair entry tag. If you are using a wine kit, list the brand and product name of the wine ingredients.

INSTRUCTIONS: All flowers and plants entered for competition must have been grown by the exhibitor except in arrangement classes where purchased flowers and material are permitted. ENTRY TAGS MUST BE TIED (NOT TAPED) TO EXHIBIT. NO SILK FLOWERS OR ARTIFICIAL MATERIAL ALLOWED UNLESS REQUESTED. PLEASE REMOVE DAMAGED, DISCOLOURED, AND DEAD MATERIALS. ALSO READ PRIZE LIST CAREFULLY AND BE SURE THAT YOUR EXHIBIT IS ENTERED IN THE CORRECT SECTION. ALL ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE ASSEMBLED BEFORE ARRIVAL AT THE EXHIBITS HALL.

Judge's Hint: Flowers and foliage should be almost at peak or peak condition and never past peak.

Should there be more than (6) six entries in any section and on the advice of the judge, a 4th prize of \$2 will be given. For changes in entries please contact the Secretary. Each exhibitor shall present his or her member's ticket when picking up exhibits for the hall at the conclusion of the fair. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.**

SECTION: CUT FLOWERS; MUST BE GROWN BY EXHIBITOR

1. Zinnias, 3 stems (stem may carry one or more flowers or buds)
2. Dahlia, 1 bloom 6" or under
3. Any perennial not listed, 1 specimen, must be named
4. Perennials, 3 stems, all different, must be named. (Stem may carry one or more flowers or buds)
5. Annuals, 3 stems, all different, must be named
6. Any annual not listed, 1 specimen, must be named
7. Rose, 1 bloom, any colour. (Bloom: individual flower, one to a stem, do not leave buds showing)
8. Black Eyed Susan, 3 stems
9. Hydrangea, 1 bloom
