## KNITTED AND CROCHETED ARTICLES CLASS 36

**INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ RULES CAREFULLY.** All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.** EACH ENTRY MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR, MUST BE CLEAN AND WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED 2 YEARS. **NOTE:** PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO NEW WORK. Any change on entry card must be made through the Committee Head only. **NOTE:** Should there be more than 6 entries in any section and on the advice of the judge, a 4th prize will be given.

All entry tags must be fastened securely to the garment ONLY with safety pins. Before removing entries from the hall, exhibitors must present their membership ticket and exhibitor number. Entries may be picked up after closing ceremonies, beginning at 4:00 pm Monday of the fair.

### SECTION KNITTED:

1. Afghan, hand knitted, one piece, not exceeding 150 cm x 180 cm
2. Afghan, hand knitted, squares, not exceeding 150 cm x 180 cm
3. Hand knitted baby's afghan or carriage cover any style (min. size 36" x 36")
4. Hand knitted pair of socks, adult size

5. Hand knitted pair of mittens, adult size
6. Hand knitted cardigan
7. Hand knitted slippers any style
8. Hand knitted hat, any style
9. Hand knitted baby outfit, minimum 2 pieces, no ribbons (no chunky or thick yarn)
10. Any hand knitted article by new exhibitor
11. A scarf or cowl article hand knitted for an adult
12. Any article of machine knitting or any other technique
13. A shawl or shrug

**SECTION CROCHETED:**

14. Afghan crocheted, not exceeding 150 cm x 180 cm
15. Any Animal crocheted, not exceeding 40 cm x 40 cm or smaller than 10 cm x 10 cm
16. Baby afghan or carriage cover any style (min. 36" x 36")
17. One pair crocheted slippers, any style or size
18. Crocheted baby outfit, minimum 2 pieces – no ribbons (no chunky or thick yarn)
19. Any article crocheted by a new exhibitor

**PRIZE MONEY:** Sections 1 to 20: 1st \$5, 2nd \$4, 3rd \$3
