INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ RULES CAREFULLY. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. Exhibitors must present exhibitors ticket when collecting their entries on the Monday of the Fair at 4:45 pm. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.** Exhibitor's entry tag must be filled out with correct section number and name. Only one entry per person per section is allowed. Please indicate age on outside of tag when entering adult sections if you are 18 years of age or under.

SECTIONS:

1. Wood carving – animals with four legs ie. dog, bear, cat
2. Wood carving – animals with two legs or less ie. birds, fish, snakes
3. Article made using wood burning technique (based off of a picture)
4. An article made from recycled wood
5. Child's toy – train, truck, airplane, puzzles, etc.
6. Any Woodworking Project – for students ages 12 and under – can be made from a kit – state age on entry tag.
7. Any Woodworking Project – for students 13 to 18 years of age – can be made from a kit – state age on entry tag.
8. Hanging project – must be able to hang on the wall

INSTRUCTIONS: All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. The exhibitor must present his/her exhibitor ticket and number to one of the directors. At the advice of the judge, a 4th prize may be awarded. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homecraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.**

NOTE: ALL ART MUST BE FRAMED OR MOUNTED AND READY TO HANG
N.B. Art is hung on gallery wires [hooks] in multiple layers. String, taped, cardboard backing and weak hanging apparatus will be disqualified as they may fall and damage displayed work. This rule strictly enforced! Work not ready for display with properly attached hanging device will be disqualified.) EXCLUDING SECTIONS 12, 13, 14 & 15. Due to limited display space, finished works, (including frame, mountings and bases) must not exceed 75 cm (30 inches) in any direction. ALL ART MUST BE THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR. AN EXHIBITOR MAY ENTER ONLY ONE PIECE OF ART IN EACH SECTION. N.B. water colour pencils are included in water colour categories.
New work each year is expected.

SECTIONS:

1. "Winter Day" – Oil or acrylic 2 dimensional
2. "Winter Day" – Water colour or other medium, 2 dimensional
3. "Orange" – any medium, 2 dimensional
