INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ FAIR RULES CAREFULLY. Each entry must be the work of the exhibitor and only one entry per section. All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. **Please refer to rule #5 in the Homcraft Rules & Regulations on pg. 96.** Entries from Sections 1 - 26 must be in CLEAR PLASTIC ZIPPER BAGS PROVIDED BY THE EXHIBITOR WITH TAGS ATTACHED. Exhibitors shall present their exhibitor card with a list of entries shown, before removing exhibits Monday at 4:30 pm.

SECTION: BREAD & ROLLS (YEAST)

For Sections 1 and 2 loaf pan should be 8" x 4" x 2 1/2" min., and 9" x 5" x 3" max. Bread machine only permitted in Section 3.

1. 1/2 loaf white bread
2. 1/2 loaf 60% whole wheat bread
3. One loaf of multi-grain bread, using a bread machine
4. 1/2 braided fruit loaf
5. Three white clover-leaf buns
6. Three Chelsea buns, presented on a 6" plate

OAAS BUTTER TART COMPETITION: Five 3” tarts, with raisins – NO NUTS



RULES:

1. Entry must be solely made by the person entering the competition (including pastry).
2. The entrant must have won the OAAS butter tart competition at the local Fair/Exhibition to be eligible to enter the District Competition.
3. The entrant must have won the District Competition to be eligible to enter the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Competition at the convention in February 2021.
4. In the case where the District winner is unable to send an entry to the convention, then the 2nd prize district winner will be eligible to enter.
5. The size of tarts must be full size tarts (no mini or bite size tarts)
6. No nuts or any other fruit. Only raisins are to be included.
7. Tarts must be on a clean paper plate inside of a clear plastic bag.
8. **At Provincial Competition**, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place entries will not be returned to exhibitor but will be placed for auction at the convention.

GLADYS KEELER AWARD: Trophy presented to person with the highest number of points accumulated in Sections 1-30. Trophy to be kept by winner and returned prior to the next year’s fair. Winner to engrave trophy prior to returning.

A Special Award of \$20 will be given to the exhibitor with most points in Sections 1-30, **sponsored by ERIN AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY.** To be presented in the Exhibits Hall, Centre Stage during closing ceremonies beginning at 4:00 pm, Monday of Fair.
