INSTRUCTIONS: Suggestions for winning entries, items to be placed on **SMALL** paper plates and covered with **CLEAN PLASTIC BAGS OR PLASTIC WRAP** (PROVIDED BY THE EXHIBITOR) with the exception of **CAKES** which must be on **STURDY CARDBOARD COVERED WITH FOIL. Please indicate age on outside of entry tag.** All entries must be in the Exhibit Hall by 10:00 am Friday of the Fair and may be picked up AFTER closing ceremonies, 4:00 pm on Monday of the Fair. NOTE: THIS CLASS IS OPEN TO ALL CHILDREN WHO HAVE REACHED THEIR 16TH BIRTHDAY BY THE END OF THIS FALL FAIR YEAR. PARENTS ARE URGED TO ALLOW THE CHILDREN TO DO THE WORK AND PREPARATION OF THE EXHIBITS WITHOUT ASSISTANCE. PLEASE ENCOURAGE THEM IN EVERY WAY, BUT REMEMBER THAT EVERY BIT OF WORK YOU DO FOR THEM HELPS DEFEAT THE OBJECTIVES OF THE FAIR. NO MIXES TO BE USED. NO MIXES OR PURCHASED PIE FILLING OR PASTRY.

AGES 6 AND UNDER - Please indicate age on outside of entry tag

1. Cake Mix Cookies – choose any flavour of cake mix, add 2 eggs and 1/2 cup vegetable oil. Mix together, roll into balls and bake at 350° for 6 - 10 mins. Display 3 on a small plate
2. No Bake Cinnamon Rolls
Ingredients – 2 slices white bread – no crusts, 2 tbsp each of butter, cinnamon sugar, icing sugar, 1/8 tsp of water or as needed
Instructions – using rolling pin, roll out bread until flat. Butter the bread and sprinkle with cinnamon sugar. Roll up tightly and cut into pieces. Mix icing sugar with water to make thin frosting, drizzle over bread. Display 3 pieces on small plate.
3. Fall Teepee – using an upside down ice cream cone, decorate to create a fall themed teepee
4. Pancake – make one pancake and display on a paper plate with your favourite toppings.
5. Marshmallow Top Hats – (5) dip half of a large marshmallow into melted chocolate and sprinkle with your favourite toppings ie- sprinkles, crushed smarties, nerds.

AGES 7-11 - Please indicate age on outside of entry tag

6. Dried Fruit – Dry 3 different types of fruit and display in a sandwich sized ziploc bag
7. Soda Biscuits – using the following recipe make and display 3 biscuits
Ingredients – 3 1/3 cups flour, 1 tsp salt, 1 tsp baking soda, milk
What to do – Preheat the oven to 425° F. Take a large bowl and fill it with flour. Then, proceed to scoop in one tablespoon of milk at a time until the dough turns stiff. Set aside. Get a separate bowl where you can dissolve the baking soda in a tablespoon of milk. Afterward, pour it into the stiff dough mixture. Roll the dough out until it turns into a fine, thin layer. Cut circles using a cookie cutter and then bake them in an oven for 15 minutes until the edges turn brown.
8. Banana Bread – 3 x 1” pieces
9. Oatmeal Raisin cookies – 3 cookies
10. Chocolate Truffles – 4 pieces

11. Peanut Brittle – 3 pieces
12. Maple Fudge – 4 x 1” pieces
13. Pioneer Breakfast – will be judged on appearance
14. Sugar Cookie S’more Tacos – (3) use your favourite sugar cookie recipe, fold to look like taco shape, and bake. Let cool then fill with s’more filling and broil 2 min.
15. Cornmeal Muffins – 3 displayed

CANNING: Jars must be sealed with new lids (filled to 1/2” from top), half-pint, 8 oz jars or metric equivalent
