

Erin Agricultural Society Ambassador Agreement

1. Ambassadors are expected to be at the 2021 Erin Fall Fair at the following times:
 - a. **Friday, October 8** - Competition to commence at 5pm sharp. Please arrive by 4:00pm. Competition to conclude by 7pm. Sr, Sr Runner-up, Jr and Jr Runner-up to stay later to bring greetings at track.
 - b. **Saturday, October 9** - 9am to 9pm (times subject to change)
 - c. **Sunday, October 10** - 9am to 9pm (times subject to change)
 - d. **Monday, October 11** - 9am to 5pm

*If ambassadors require to be absent during the above times (family dinners etc), please speak with the Ambassador Committee.

2. Ambassadors must follow dress code at all times. Any clothing deemed inappropriate by the ambassador committee must be changed immediately. **Business Casual:**
 - a. No skirts/dresses shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
 - b. No blue jeans to be worn. Black jeans are accepted.
 - c. Show clothing may be worn with approval by the Ambassador Committee.
 - d. All shirts must have straps at least 2 inches wide.
 - e. No leggings; unless worn under a skirt/dress.
3. Ambassadors may not drink alcohol, smoke, be under the influence of drugs or exhibit rude/lewd behaviour while wearing their sash or while representing the Erin Agricultural Society.
4. Ambassadors may participate at various events throughout the year, including visits to neighboring fairs. Ambassadors are expected to arrange transportation to these events if necessary.

5. Ambassadors may attend the following events as they continue to hold their title through 2021-2022. Dates and times TBD.
 - a. District 7 Meeting
 - b. Erin Santa Claus Parade
 - c. OAAS Convention February 2022 - **Senior Ambassador Only. Transportation and accommodations provided.**
 - d. CNE Ambassador of the Fairs Competition August 2022 TBD - **Senior Ambassador Only. Transportation and accommodations provided.**
 - e. Erin Fall Fair 2022 Thursday and Friday.
 - f. Various Volunteer Opportunities such as the EAS Drive In Chicken BBQ. These opportunities are not mandatory however we encourage the Ambassadors to attend if they are available.
6. If ambassadors wish to attend a non committee approved event during the year, they must first ask permission of the Ambassador Committee.
7. All ambassadors must provide a written review of their time as ambassador, which will be read at the Erin Agricultural Society Annual General Meeting. A copy must be submitted to the Ambassador Committee by January 1, 2022.
8. The Senior and Junior Ambassador must provide a write up for the 2022 Erin Fall Fair book. A copy must be submitted to the Ambassador Committee by May 1st, 2022.
9. The Senior and Junior Ambassador's will receive their scholarship prizes in 3 installments on the following dates:
 - a. October 2021
 - b. February 2022
 - c. October 2022

Senior Ambassador: \$1500 + \$200 clothing allowance for CNE

Senior Runner-Up Ambassador: \$750

Junior Ambassador: \$500

Junior Runner-Up Ambassador: \$250

An ambassador who does not attend the expected functions, or is found to be in violation of the rules and expectations may face penalties. I understand that failure to comply with this agreement will warrant the Erin Agricultural Society to withhold, at their discretion, some or all of the Ambassador scholarship; and/or release me from my duties altogether.
